**DISCUSSION**

Capital repair/improvement projects for this summer include Repairs to the roof, the parking lot and the tile floor of meeting room A/B. A capital funding of about \$50,000 is needed. The matter was referred to Building and Grounds and to Finance for review and advice and will be considered at the next meeting.

**DECISION**

The revised listserv facility policy designed to make e-mail-based discussion among members of the parish was presented. The updated form reflecting a final change is attached. After further discussion and upon motion duly made and seconded, it was unanimously:

RESOLVED that the Vestry authorizes the use of the *St. Aidan's Community Listserv Policy* and authorizes the Rector or such person or persons as the Rector may from time to time designate to make reasonable and customary changes in or exceptions to the policy, consistent with the needs and the interests of St. Aidan's.

We hope that this list will help us to build community and fellowship within the church. It is a great place to do these things—

- Organize an informal event such as a hike with church members
- Invite the church community to a Bible Study or other event
- Share things in common—if you are giving away a couch or a coffee pot for free, perhaps there is someone in the church who needs it
- Help each other—if you are moving, perhaps church members are available to come help on moving day

In order for this to work to build up our community with good expectations of one another, we do have a few requests. The listserv is moderated, which means that all messages will be reviewed before being posted. We ask that you abide by these guidelines when you are using the listserv:

- To RSVP to an event, please email the individual, not the whole list.
- Please post events and other items that relate to our common life in service and fellowship. This list is not the place to have conversations about theology or polity or other denominations or churches.
- Please do not post about items for sale.
