The Reception area will be renamed the **Muriel Sibell Wolle Gallery at St. Aidan's** with the purpose of showing artwork of the students of the University of Colorado.

The grand opening will be the week prior to the annual meeting in January and we would like to have a showing of many of the pieces done by Muriel Sibell Wolle.

We have met with Professor George Rivera, of the art department at the University of Colorado; Scott Fraser, artist and parishioner; Mary Kate, & Dustin. Professor Rivera has given us many good ideas, and is very interested in assisting us in any way that he can. He has promised to deliver students who will be interested in displaying their art work. We are currently working on the details involved to be able to host student art, and give them the experience in showing their work. This would involve frames, waivers, forms and essential paperwork. Bill Sweeney tells us that our Church Insurance will not cover the loss of any of these works of art. Therefore, the waiver is to cover that possibility. The approval of the Vestry to continue to develop this plan is most definitely important. We would like to hear your feedback and any ideas that you might have on this proposal.
